

To enable students to fully benefit from digitalized learning, and meet the new learning environment demands brought by mobile teaching methods, **True Light Middle School of Hong Kong** set about building open learning space on its school campus, which includes reconstructing the Multi-media Learning Centre facilities and converting the School Library functions. The new learning space was named “TL Oasis”, which takes the meaning of “being the spring of knowledge”.

The school altered the installations inside the Computer Room and Multi-media Learning Centre. The original stationary desktop computers and wire network, which were the main installations in the past, are replaced by wireless network coverage to facilitate students in using mobile computer equipment for learning. By installing movable sound-proof partitions, the partition wall itself can turn into a projection screen for teachers and students to use flexibly. The complete audio-visual combination and the easily movable chairs with desk attached help students interact and learn in groups, as well as assisting them to carry out cross-curricular digitalized learning activities, such as project work and drama rehearsals.

Besides, the School Library was thoroughly reconstructed. It has now got wireless network coverage, and notebook computers are provided for students. As a result, not only can students use the general library facilities (e.g. different types of library books, magazines, periodicals and other audio-visual resources), they can also browse online resources and digitalized reading materials. The Library has been converted into a student self-access centre to raise students’ interest in pursuing knowledge. The design of “TL Oasis” accentuates the feeling of space and allows the maximum use of natural lighting, while the layout of bookshelves, tables and chairs mainly adopts a streamline design. Students can perform different kinds of learning activities in a spacious and well-lighted area to promote peer exchange.
